#### **Absentee Ballots as per Local Lodge Bylaws (Article IV)**

Any member entitled to receive an Absentee Ballot may complete in full the 2323 Absentee Request form available from the 2323 website ([www.iamaw2323.ca](http://www.iamaw2323.ca)) and also available in the Shop Committee Offices. The member must forward it to the Recording Secretary via Canada Post, email, or by handing it in, in person, to the Recording Secretary. Absentee Ballot requests must be sent in individual envelopes.

Absentee Ballot request must be received not less than 30 days before the election.

Please don't forget to complete the form in full including a valid union card number and your signature. If you don't have your union card number you can get it by calling the Local Lodge office at 905-678-0010. At the polling station on December 07, 2021, a valid union card or a government issued picture identification must be presented or a ballot will not be issued.
