Through immediate and direct engagement, your **Shift Bid Committee** and **Shop Committee** acted swiftly to challenge these proposals and advocate for the preservation of established standards that have guided our operation for decades. As a result, several of the Company's initial changes were withdrawn or revised following strong representation from your Union.

The bid cycling process has now been completed, and the final bid package will be posted shortly for members to review.

While we continue to operate under **Memorandum of Agreement No. 12**, which grants the Company authority to produce schedules while the Union cycles them through the **Workplace Cycling Committee**, our role remains clear — to ensure that every decision reflects past practice, fairness, and the hard-earned rights of our members.
