- 1. Canned or non-perishable food items
- 2. Baby formula and diapers
- 3. Hygiene products (soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, feminine products)
- 4. First aid supplies
- 5. Blankets and light bedding
- 6. Flashlights
- 7. Cleaning supplies (disinfectant wipes, gloves, garbage bags)
- 8. Basic clothing (t-shirts, socks, undergarments)

Collection bins will be available in all designated shop committee offices from November 8 to November 22, 2025.

All collected items will be prepared and shipped in coordination with GlobalMedic, who are already on the ground ensuring the safe and direct distribution of aid to affected regions.

We also extend our sincere appreciation to senior management teams across all branches for coming together and collaborating with us to make this relief initiative possible. Their support has ensured that these critical supplies will reach those who need them most.
